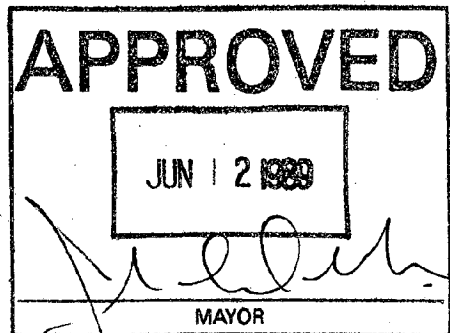
RESOLVED, That Angell Street, from Wayland Avenue to Moses Brown Street be established as a One-Way Street, in an easterly direction.

RE: ONE WAY STREET RESOLUTIONS

In order to be in conformance with State of Rhode Island and Federal Highway Administration guidelines for the posting of the detour for the Interstate Route I-195 Providence River Bridge detour, the following one way street patterns have been recommended by the State and Federal Highway Administration:

Angell Street, one way in an easterly direction, from  
Wayland Avenue to Moses Brown Street

James Street, one way in a westerly direction, from  
South Main Street to South Water Street

These one way streets will be in effect from May 22, 1989 through November 1989.

Since it is too late to be included in the "Docket" for the City Council Meeting on Thursday, May 18, 1989, I am respectfully requesting that the above one way resolutions be introduced to the City Council as an addendum to the meeting of May 18, 1989, and be passed.

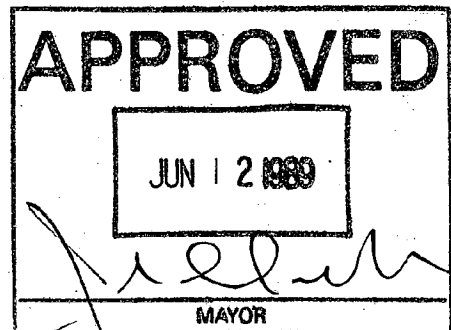

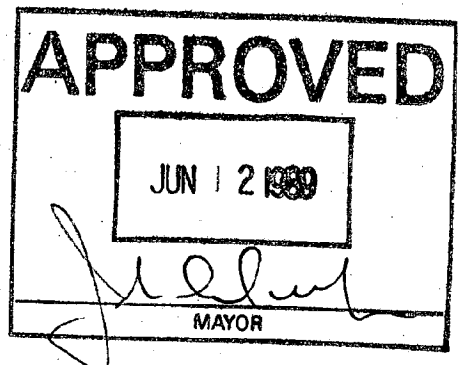

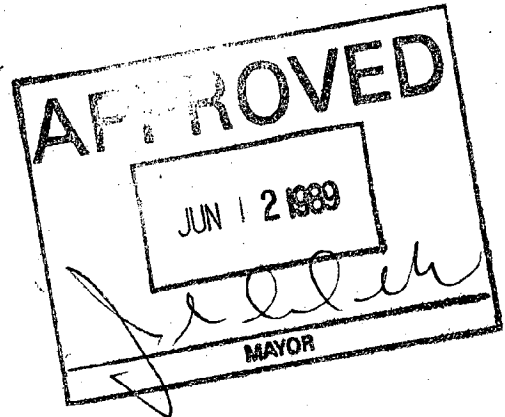
