NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council expresses its sincere hope that David and Nina will attain "the highest measure of earthly happiness" and

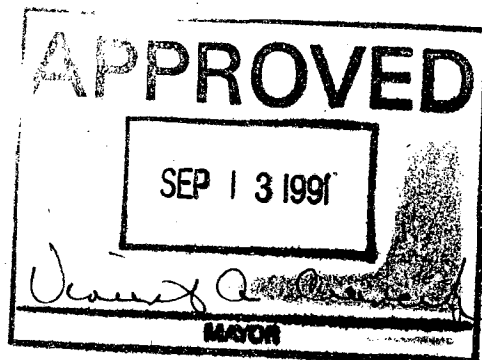
