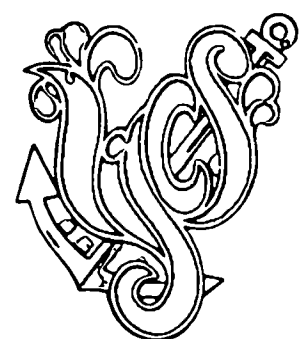
Subject : "Jack Comley Dedication"

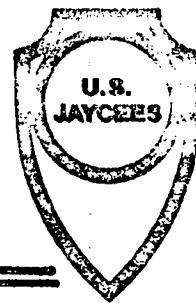
