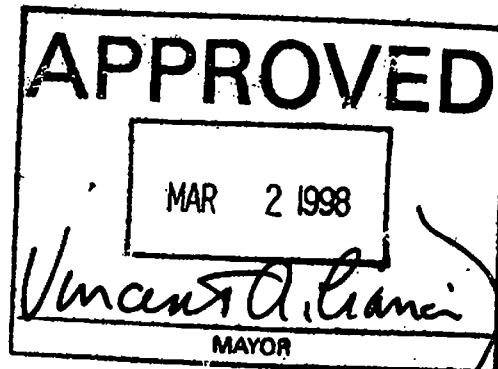

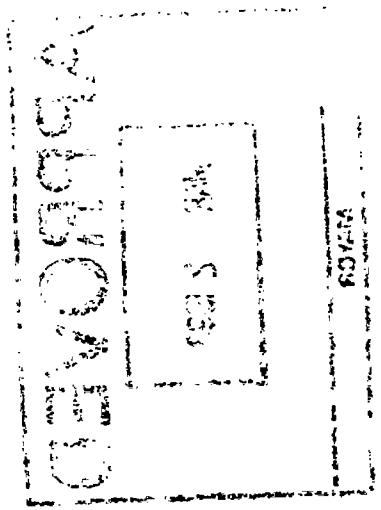

RE: Resolution for Cox Communications Cable to carry 24 hour
Hispanic Channel

As per our conversation, I did research your request inquiring about the rumor of Cox Cable Company not carrying the Hispanic Channel 24 hours a day. I spoke John Wolf with Cox Communications. Mr. Wolf has explained to me that they receive their transmission from WUNI Channel 27, from Worcester MA.

The problem is that Univision which is a 24 hour satellite broadcasting service no longer broadcasts their shows to WUNI, which in return broadcasts to Cox Communications. They are in negotiations to rectify this problem.

However, Mr. Wolf also states that the Hispanic Channel will remain broadcasting Hispanic programs. There will be a few hours a day when they will broadcast shows with english speaking languages with Spanish undertones.

As per your request, a resolution will be done, including census numbers of hispanics within the City of Providence. However, we will be forwarding this request to the City Clerk's office.
