

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 741

Approved September 22, 1975

WHEREAS, the breakdown of morals, family, respect for authority, and law and order is reaching the epidemic stage, and

WHEREAS, our community is besieged by literature, movies, bad influences and entertainment which are misleading our youth and encouraging our youth of immoral attitudes, which are destroying many lives and harming many families, and



WHEREAS, many young people do not apparently know right from wrong, so many not having the benefit of proper religious training or homes with strong moral values, and


WHEREAS, the Ordinances of this City and the law of this State require;

- 1.) Respect of the rights of persons;
- 2.) Respect for the rights of property and
- 3.) Respect for law and order

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that just as we teach in schools hygiene and preventive medicine, and fire prevention, so should we teach basic principles of right from wrong incorporated in our civil and criminal laws, so that, at an early age, we develop respect for property, person and law and order.
