NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Traffic Engineer and other appropriate departments of the City are requested to take appropriate action to close the below listed streets on the dates and during the times indicated below:

Friday, June 2, 1989 and Saturday, June 3, 1989,
from 5:30 o'clock P.M. to 10:00 o'clock P.M.

Cushing Street, from Brown Street to Congdon Street;
Brown Street, from Meeting Street to Bowen Street;
Congdon Street, from South Court Street to Cushing
Street.

Saturday, June 3, 1989, from 9:00 o'clock A.M. to
4:00 o'clock P.M.


Orchard Avenue, from Wayland Avenue to Butler Avenue;
Oriole Avenue, from Paterson Street to Parkside Road;
East Orchard Avenue at Parkside Road.


Sunday, June 4, 1989, from 11:30 o'clock A.M.

Princeton Avenue, from Elmwood Avenue to Broad Street;
