The Traffic Engineering Department has received the following resolution from your Committee and has taken the subsequent action:

Request: That the Traffic Engineer is requested to investigate and report to the Committee on Public Work, as to the feasibility of extending the bus route westerly, along Chalkstone Avenue, by relocating the presently employed public transportation bus turnabout stop at Chalkstone Avenue and Sission Street, in favor of a new location, at Chalkstone Avenue and Obediah Brown Road; said proposed location being City-owned property; and further to establish new bus stops along both the curblines of Chalkstone Avenue at Sisson Street.
