

The following memo is a response to resolution 8 to be heard at the 1/17/18 Public Works Committee Meeting

1. Resolution Requesting the Public Works Director to cause the installation of speed humps or other traffic calming measures on Harold Street from Chalkstone Avenue to Regent Avenue.

**Response:** There is currently a request for traffic calming on Harold St. that is to be heard by the Traffic Calming Advisory Group. Traffic Engineering has committed to conducting a speed and traffic volume count once weather conditions allow for a proper count.
