# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 239

Approved April 5, 1963

**Whereas,** by Resolution No. 315 approved May 19, 1961, the City Council of the City of Providence authorized the City Treasurer acting under the direction of the Committee on Finance, to borrow from time to time, in such sums as may be necessary, not exceeding \$500,000 and to issue the City's notes therefor, signed by him and countersigned by the Mayor and the Chairman of the Committee on Finance, and to renew any such notes from time to time as the same become due; and

WHEREAS, said resolution further provided that the money thus obtained shall be used exclusively by the Providence Redevelopment Agency for the purpose of undertaking early land acquisition activities for the Weybosset Hill Project designated as account number R. I. R-7; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to conduct further surveys and redevelopment activities for the Weybosset Hill Project which requires utilization of funds remaining from the authorized amount of \$500,000 still unexpended.

RESOLVED, that in addition to carrying out the early land acquisition activities for Weybosset Hill Project for which moneys not to exceed \$500,000 was authorized by Resolution No. 315, approved May 19, 1961, the Providence Redevelopment Agency is authorized to expend the unspent funds from the authorized \$500,000 for necessary surveys and other redevelopment activities for the Weybosset Hill Project R. I. R-7 and the City Treasurer is authorized, pursuant to the procedures set forth in said Resolution No. 315 approved May 19, 1961 to obtain any remaining sums from the authorized amount of \$500,000 in order to permit the Providence Redevelopment Agency to carry out the activities authorized hereby.


