Approved December 29, 1978

WHEREAS, Sex or age shall not be a factor in determining the cost of automobile insurance coverage, and

WHEREAS, No person shall be placed in an assigned risk pool without proper justification based on an individual's past driving record, and

WHEREAS, Initial application for automobile insurance coverage is not significant justification to place an applicant in an assigned risk pool,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Director of the State Department of Business Regulation and the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Rhode Island are hereby requested to effect a revision of the "pool-plan", so-called and the factor of sex or age being a determination in the cost of automobile insurance coverage, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That said Director of the State Department of Business Regulation and the Insurance Commissioner are requested to report their study and results to the City Council of Providence.
