CHAPTER 1070

No. 545 **AN ORDINANCE** AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE CHAPTER 1051, APPROVED SEPTEMBER 20, 1956 BY ADDING THE SUM OF FIFTEEN THOUSAND (\$15,000) DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR SCHOOL DEPARTMENT, SAID SUM TO BE EXPENDED FOR CUSTODIANS' SALARIES IN CONNECTION WITH THE USE OF PUBLIC SCHOOL BUILDINGS BY COMMUNITY SERVICE AGENCIES FOR YOUTH ACTIVITIES.

Approved November 2, 1956

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1: Chapter 1051 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as approved September 20, 1956, entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$33,514,967.90 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1957", is hereby amended by adding the sum of Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000) Dollars to the appropriation contained therein for SCHOOL DEPARTMENT, said sum to be expended for Custodians' salaries in connection with the use of Public School Buildings by Community Service Agencies for Youth activities.

SECTION 2: The said sum of Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000) Dollars as thus added and appropriated shall be charged to the General Fund from Funds Not Otherwise Appropriated.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

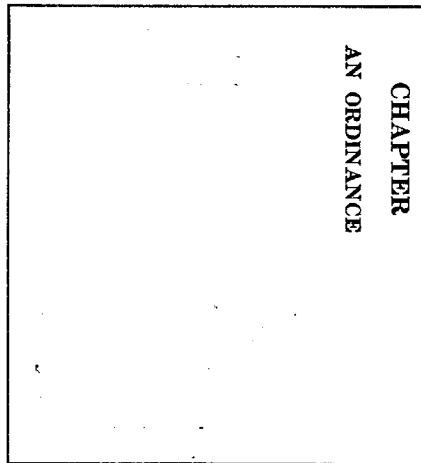
