RESOLVED, DECREED AND ORDERED:

That the following named street, shown as cross-hatched area on the accompanying plan entitled, "Providence, R.I., P.W. Dept. Engineering Office Street Line Section Plan No. 064091 Dated: July 20, 1979",

viz:

Mississippi Avenue, from the easterly line of Narragansett Boulevard to the easterly termination, shown as cross-hatched area (A-B-C-D-A), having ceased to be useful to the public and the same is hereby abandoned as a Public Highway and the damage to the abutters is appraised at nothing and so awarded, subject to drainage structure in Mississippi Avenue becoming private and the City will have no responsibility in maintenance of it.

ORDERED, That the Director of Public Works, be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed on the above-named street abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words, "Not a Public Highway" and it is further

ORDERED, That after the entry of this order or decree, the City Clerk shall cause a notice, thereof, to be published in a newspaper published in the County of Providence at least once a week for three successive weeks, and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting the above-named highway which has been abandoned, who is known to reside within the State.

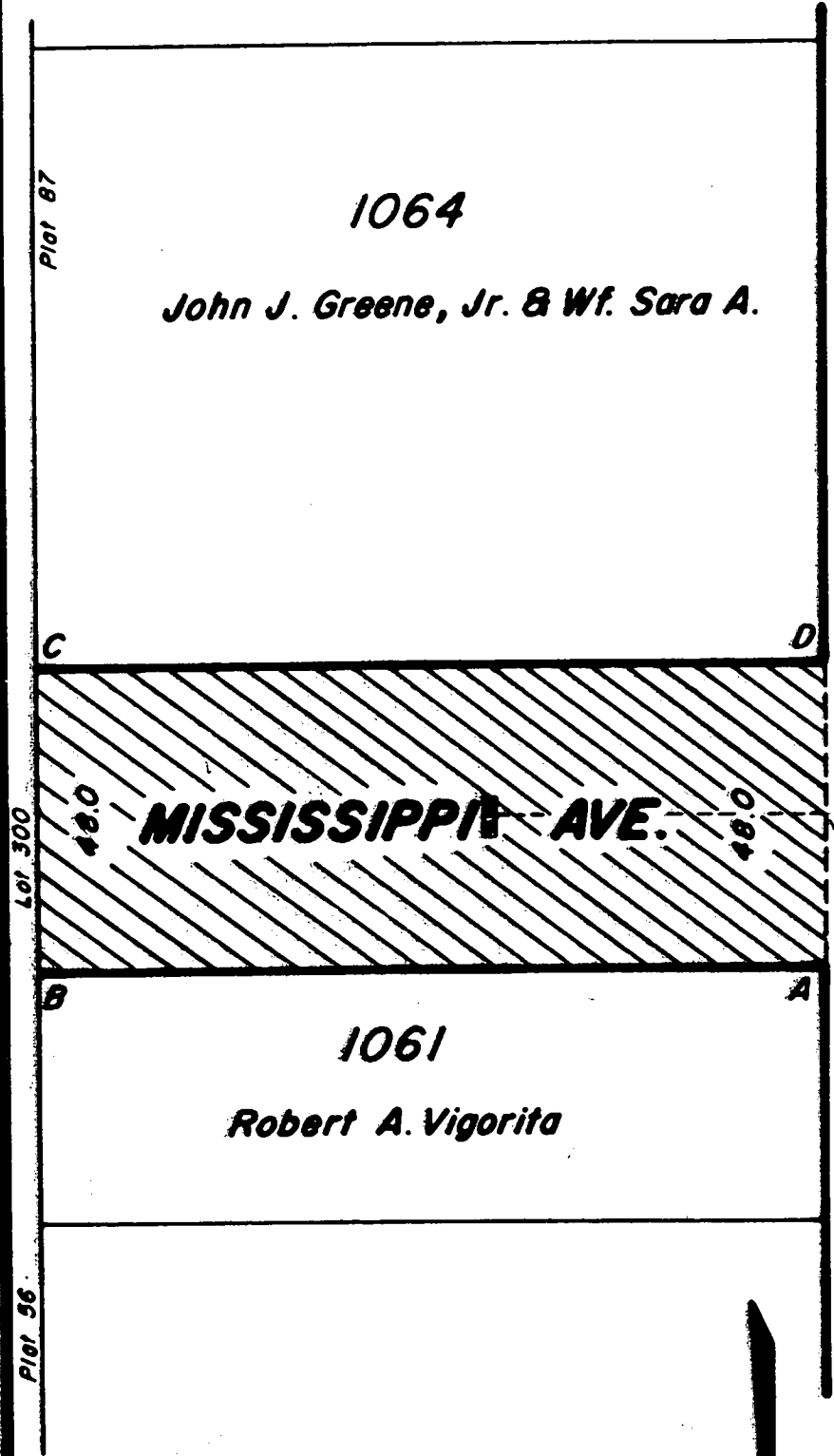
