# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 446

Approved September 9, 1974

RESOLVED, That the Governor of the State of Rhode Island is hereby requested to direct the Secretary of State of the State of Rhode Island to submit a question in substantially the following form to the electorate of the City of Providence at the general state election to be held November 5, 1974:

"Shall 'An Act Providing for Remodeling, Re-constructing, Rehabilitating, Modernizing and Improving Municipal Dock Buildings and Facilities by the City of Providence and Authorizing the Financing Thereof, Including the Issue of Not More Than \$2,000,000 Bonds Therefor' be approved?"
