MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: 1975-1976 BUDGET
CONSIDERED BY: City Clerk, Vincent Vespia

DISPOSITION: In accordance with Provisions of Resolution of the City Council No. 429, Approved May 21, 1975, a copy of which is hereto attached, your Clerk met with the Director of the Department of Communications for a preliminary survey to determine the cost of the installation of an appropriate Public Address System within the Chamber of the City Council.

It is recommendation of the Director that the placement of twenty-eight individual microphones at the desks of the President, each Member of the City Council and at the desk of the Clerk, adequately wired and all the necessary amplification apparatus installation would cost approximately Three Thousand Dollars, (\$3,000.00).
