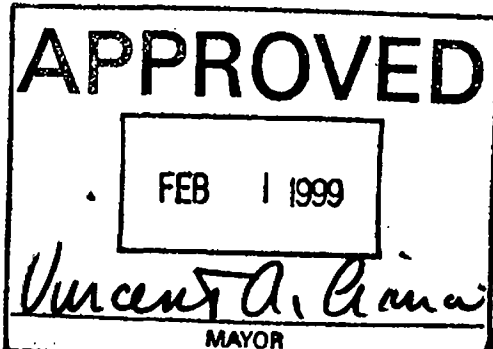

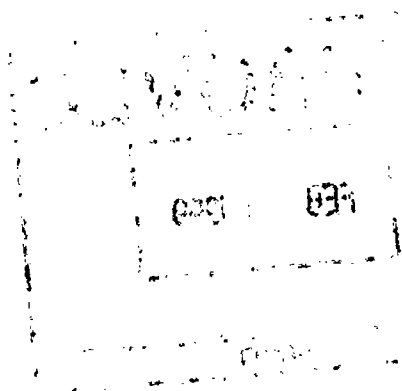


We also request that this area on Benefit Street be marked with the yellow and black DO NOT PARK tape. If we can assist with this please let us know.

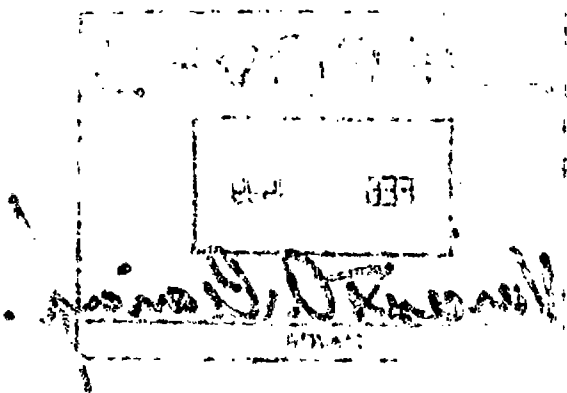
