Dear Councilwoman Young:

Southside Community Land Trust (SCLT) is planning to hold its annual City Fest on August 25, 2001. This event is our end of the season party for the nearly 200 neighborhood children who have taken part in our summer long Children's Garden program.

The children invite their parents and friends to City Farm to show off what they have learned and what they have grown. Area vendors have agreed to donate food and beverages so that we can offer them to the children at no cost. We have several artists (jugglers, storytellers, and face painters) who will be entertaining the crowd, and children's games and activities are also planned.

We would like your help in closing Linden Street, between West Clifford and Providence Streets, on the 25th. It is our hope to use the street area for the performers while the children's activities take place within City Farm. City Fest is scheduled to run from noon until 3pm.

We are also requesting that Linden Street be closed on September 15th to allow for a fundraising event at City Farm, 2001: A Spice Odyssey. This is our third year for the event and it is a major source of income for us as well as a chance to bring people from all over the area to see the work being done by us and others in South Providence. The event is from 4 to 7pm, with set up beginning at 8am.

While asking to close the same street twice in two months might seem excessive, I would note that there are no houses on Linden. The house closest to the street on West Clifford has children who take part in the Children's Garden program and they will be attending City Fest. Their parents are welcome to attend the fundraiser. Linden Street runs between our Community Gardens and our City Farm, with vacant lots at either end of the street.

We hope that you will look favorably on both of our requests. Your help in closing the street for these events is greatly appreciated.



