RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 550

Approved September 9, 1977

WHEREAS, death has recently taken from our midst Antonio Pace, erstwhile Italian Language Radio Commentator, who, as such, kept his vast audience informed of events in their language, and

WHEREAS, the late Cavaliere Pace, a graduate of the Italian Naval Academy, was honored by the Government of the Republic of Italy as a Cavaliere del Lavoro and with the Star of Solidarity, and

WHEREAS, Cavaliere Pace, a pioneer in Italian Language Radio Broadcasting as early as the 1930's, became an important segment of that language, with daily radio shows over local stations within the hearing signal of the State of Rhode Island,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that in the passing from this life of our distinguished bi-linguist, Cavaliere Antonio Pace, the City Council of the City of Providence, pauses in its deliberation to offer prayers for his eternal repose and to express to his wife, Mary, and their family, their sympathy in this their period of bereavement.
