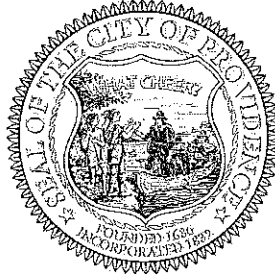

#### COUNCIL PRESIDENT APONTE, (By Request):

Resolution Establishing a Working Group to ensure the proper implementations and enforcement of the Community Safety Act.

**RESOLVED**, That There shall be a working group to review the proposed Community Safety Act (CSA), including but not limited to identifying issues of concerns and problems, identify proposed solutions, propose and create recommendations, take all appropriate evidence and testimony and provide a written review and a recommendation report to the City Council Committee on Ordinances, to be submitted prior to the Providence City Council taking action on the proposed Community Safety Act (CSA) on June 1, 2017. The working group shall consist of the following members:

- the Commissioner of Public Safety, or his designee;
- the Chief of Police, or his designee;
- the President of the Fraternal Order of Police, Providence, Lodge #3, or his designee;
- the City Solicitor, or his designee;
- the Chairman of the Committee on Ordinances;
- an appointee selected by the Mayor;
- two (2) City Council members, appointed by the Council President;
- three (3) community members, appointed by the Council President.


