AN ORDINANCE

In Amendment of Establishing the Classes of Position the Maximum Number of Employees and the Number of Employees in Certain Classes in the Water Supply Board and Repealing Ordinance Chapter 1999-34, Effective October 19, 1999. As Amended.

Approved March 23, 2000

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

Section 1. The number of employees in the Providence Water Supply Board shall not exceed two hundred sixty seven (267) at any one time. Within each of the following classifications, there shall be no more than:


WHEREAS, the Union Contract has been executed which calls for a 3.25% wage increase effective January 1, 2000 and two (2) management adjustments and an additional union position need to be contained in the compensation and position ordinances, and


WHEREAS, Providence Water has estimated and budgeted an amount sufficient to cover the wage increase and funding is available to cover the union negotiated adjustments and management upgrade from current vacant funded positions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,

1.
