

# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Approved February 5, 1973

WHEREAS, President Richard A. Nixon has reported the reaching of an agreement which will result ultimately in the cessation of the Conflict in Vietnam, and

WHEREAS, that much awaited report, and the long period of negotiations between representatives of the North Vietnamese Government and the Government of the United States of America is, to a great degree, the result of the President's leadership in bringing about the settlement as announced,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that His Honor Mayor Joseph A. Doorley, Jr., and the Members of the City Council of the City of Providence do hereby commend President Richard A. Nixon for his untiring efforts in leading the Government of the United States of America to the Peace Negotiations Table which resulted in the most gratifying report of the end of the Vietnam Conflict.
