

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 318

Approved August 14, 1972

RESOLVED, DECREED AND ORDERED,

That the portion of Grove Street from Ridge Street to its westerly termination, shown as cross-hatched area and designated by the letters A-B-C-D-A on the accompanying plan entitled, "Providence, R. I., P. W. Dept.-Engineering Office, Street Line Section, Plan No. 063568, Date July 24, 1972", has ceased to be useful to the public and the same is abandoned as a public highway and the damage to the abutters is appraised at nothing and so awarded, and it is further

ORDERED, That the Director of Public Works, be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed on the portion of Grove Street from Ridge Street to its westerly termination, abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words "Not a Public Highway", and it is further

ORDERED, That after the entry of this order or decree the City Clerk shall cause a notice thereof to be published in a newspaper published in the County of Providence at least once each week for three successive weeks and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting the portion of Grove Street from Ridge Street to its westerly termination, which has been abandoned, who is known to reside within this State.

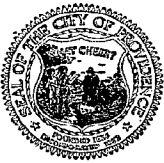

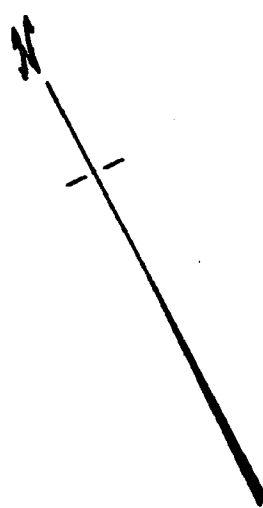

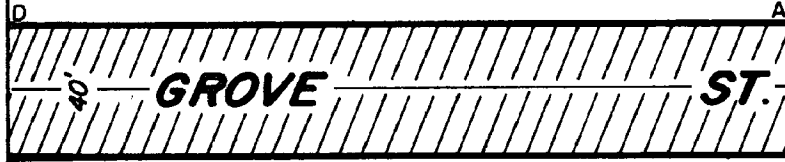

SUBJECT: Referral No. 1845 - ABANDONMENT PORTION OF GROVE STREET

Gentlemen:

This petition from the Committee on Public Works is a proposal for the abandonment of that portion of Grove Street which runs from Ridge Street to its westerly point of abutment with the Route 6 Connector (approximately 8500 sq. ft.).

The portion of Grove Street under consideration is not in use as a public highway. It is not curbed or paved and access to it is blocked by a street barrier. The surrounding area is mixed commercial, industrial and residential. A large apartment building is presently under construction on Lot 380, Plat 33, across Ridge Street from the proposed abandonment.

The proposed abandonment lies within the West Broadway Redevelopment area. Consultation with the West Broadway section of the planning department reveals a strong possibility that property in the immediate area of the proposed abandonment may be acquired by the city as part of the redevelopment plan. Consequently, it would not be feasible at this time to abandon this section of Grove Street.

VOTED: To accept the staff recommendation that this petition be denied.
