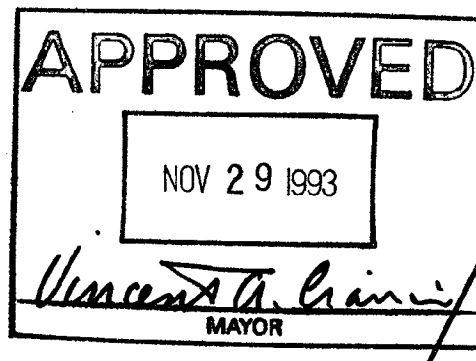
WHEREAS, the State of Rhode Island has identified Enterprise Zone 1 in the City of Providence which comprises the Port area of the City;

WHEREAS, Title 42 Chapter 64.3 Section 5 states that the Enterprise Zone Council may add Block 101 of Census Tract 135 in the City of Cranston to any Enterprise Zone abutting such block provided such addition is approved by the City Council of Providence;

WHEREAS, the addition of Block 101 of Census Tract 135 in the City of Cranston will not decrease the size of any Enterprise Zone in the City of Providence;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF CRANSTON TO PETITION THE RHODE ISLAND ENTERPRISE ZONE COUNCIL TO INCLUDE BLOCK 101 OF CENSUS TRACT 135 IN THE CITY OF CRANSTON AS PART OF ENTERPRISE ZONE 1 IN PROVIDENCE, RHODE ISLAND.

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 42-64.3-5 of the General Laws in Chapter
2 42-64.3 entitled "Enterprise Zones" is hereby amended to read as fol-
3 lows:

4 42-64.3-5. Criteria for enterprise zone designation. -- (a) The
5 zone shall consist of not more than five (5) contiguous United States
6 census tracts or portions thereof as set forth in the most recent fed-
7 eral census; except that the council may add Block 101 of Census Tract
8 135 in the city of Cranston to any enterprise zone abutting such
9 Block; provided that such addition is approved by the city councils of
10 Cranston and Providence.

11 (b) The council shall promulgate such additional criteria for the
12 designation of an enterprise zone as the council deems appropriate.
13 Additional criteria shall include but not be limited to:

14 (1) The poverty level within the enterprise zone as defined by
15 the federal office of management and budget, or the percent of house-
16 holds receiving public assistance.

17 (2) The unemployment level within the enterprise zone.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

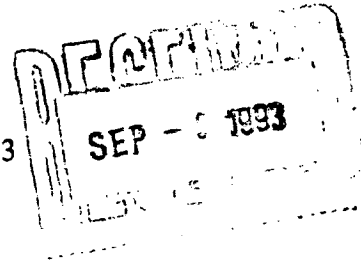



Please be advised that the Rhode Island General Assembly has recently passed and Governor Sundlun has signed into law H-7267 - An Act Relating to Enterprise Zones - which allows the City of Cranston to include Block 101 of Census Tract 135 in the City of Cranston to any enterprise zone abutting such block. Such zone would be the Port of Providence Enterprise Zone. The legislation stipulates that this amendment must receive the endorsement of both city councils of Cranston and Providence.
