During the year of 1975, the Housing Board of Review held twelve (12) meetings, three (3) of which were public hearings on appeals for exceptions under the Housing Ordinance and nine (9) of which were Executive Sessions.

Presented to the Board were six (6) appeals, all of which were inspected by the Board on field trips. There was one case continued into the new year.
