Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Chapter 1994-24, No. 365, approved June 27, 1994
shall be amended as follows:

Section 103 - Official Zoning Map, by changing the zoning
designation on Providence Zoning District Map 70, Lot 589
from C-1 Limited Commercial to C-2 General Commercial.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its
passage.

Dear Councilman James A. Petrosinelli,



