ELECTION OF ONE COUNCILMANIC MEMBER TO THE BUREAU OF LICENSES

COUNCIL PRESIDENT HAXTON calls for nominations for the Election of One Member of the City Council to the Bureau of Licenses as authorized by An Act 75H 6391, entitled AN ACT RELATING TO THE BUREAU OF LICENSES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE; passed by the General Assembly at the January Session A.D. 1975 and approved by the Governor on the nineteenth day of May, A.D. 1975.

COUNCILMAN JOHNSON nominates COUNCILMAN LAURENCE K. FLYNN and this nomination is Seconded by COUNCILMEN AHERN, CROWLEY AND FARGNOLI.

COUNCIL PRESIDENT HAXTON calls for counter-nominations and there are none.

COUNCILMAN PEARLMAN moves the matter of the subject Election be referred to the Committee on Ordinances.

This Motion is Put to Vote and Not Passed.

COUNCILMAN MANSOLILLO objects to Consideration of the Election of One Councilmanic Member to the Bureau of Licenses.

This Motion is Not Seconded and COUNCIL PRESIDENT HAXTON permits the City Council to voice its' expression and by voice Vote it does not favor the objection.

The Council thereupon proceeds to vote on said nomination by the following Roll Call Vote:

## IN GENERAL ASSEMBLY

JANUARY SESSION, A. D. 19 75

### AN ACT

RELATING TO THE BUREAU OF LICENSES  
OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE.

*It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 3339 of the public laws, 1954, entitled "An act in amendment of section 1 of chapter 2721 of the public laws, 1951, relating to the bureau of licenses of the city of Providence" and any acts in addition thereto and in amendment thereof is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SEC. 160. The Board of Licenses shall consist of five (5) members, three of which shall be appointed by the mayor with approval of the city council, not more than two (2) of whom shall be of the same political party. Appointments shall be made on the first Monday in January, 1955, or as soon thereafter as possible, and biennially thereafter. Members shall hold office until their successors are elected and qualified, two (2) of whom shall be members of the city council, one (1) of whom shall be the chairman of the <sup>City Council</sup> committee on licenses, ex officio, and one (1) of whom shall be elected by the remaining members of the council so long as he is a member of the city council. Both members of the city council shall be entitled to vote.

"SEC. 161. One member of said bureau shall be designated by the board as chairman and secretary thereof. The person designated as chairman and secretary shall be the executive officer of the bureau and shall be responsible for the issuance of all licenses granted by the bureau in accordance with law and ordinance. The members of said bureau shall receive such compensation as shall be fixed by the city council."

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage and all acts and parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

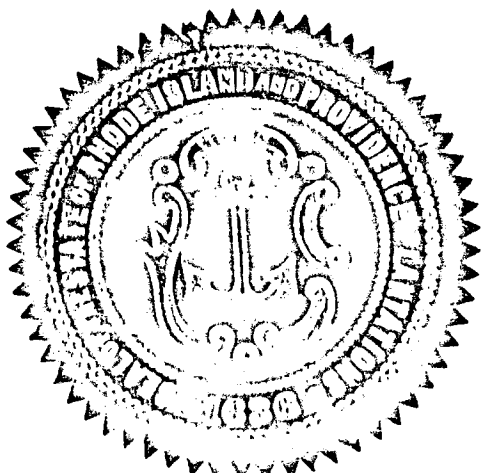
