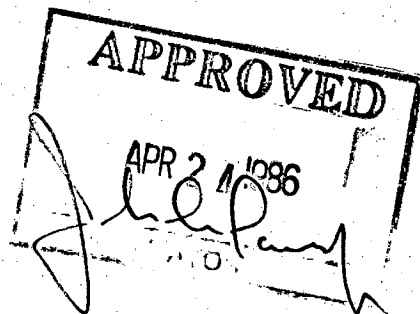

SUBJECT: BRUSH CLEARANCE

I examined the corner of Tobey and Grove Streets for protruding brush at a vacant lot which is interfering with pedestrian passage. The lot appears to be private property and outside of city jurisdiction. Regardless, the problem is unrelated to any responsibilities the Department of Public Parks would be obligated to perform.

I suggest you notify the property owner of the problem and request of him/her corrective action. Alternately, if the city must be involved, I believe the Public Works, Environmental Control Unit would be the appropriate agency to contact.
