WILSON COMPANY of approximately 27,634 square feet of land at Fields Point presently leased to said company, said new lease to be for a period of twenty (20) years and the rental to be eight (\$.08) cents per square foot for the first ten (10) years, nine (\$.09) cents per square foot for the succeeding five (5) years and ten (\$.10) cents per square foot for the last five (5) year period, said lease to contain such terms and conditions as may be approved by His Honor the Mayor and the City Solicitor. The lease shall contain a provision that G. E. Wilson Company shall have an option for a period of five (5) years to lease an additional 38,015 square feet of land adjoining the leased premises at the same rental as the area leased and that Wilson Company shall pay for said option during said period of five years an escalated price per square foot of .01, .01½, .02, .03, .05, respectively, which option, if exercised, will have the effect of including said additional land under the substituted lease herein provided for.

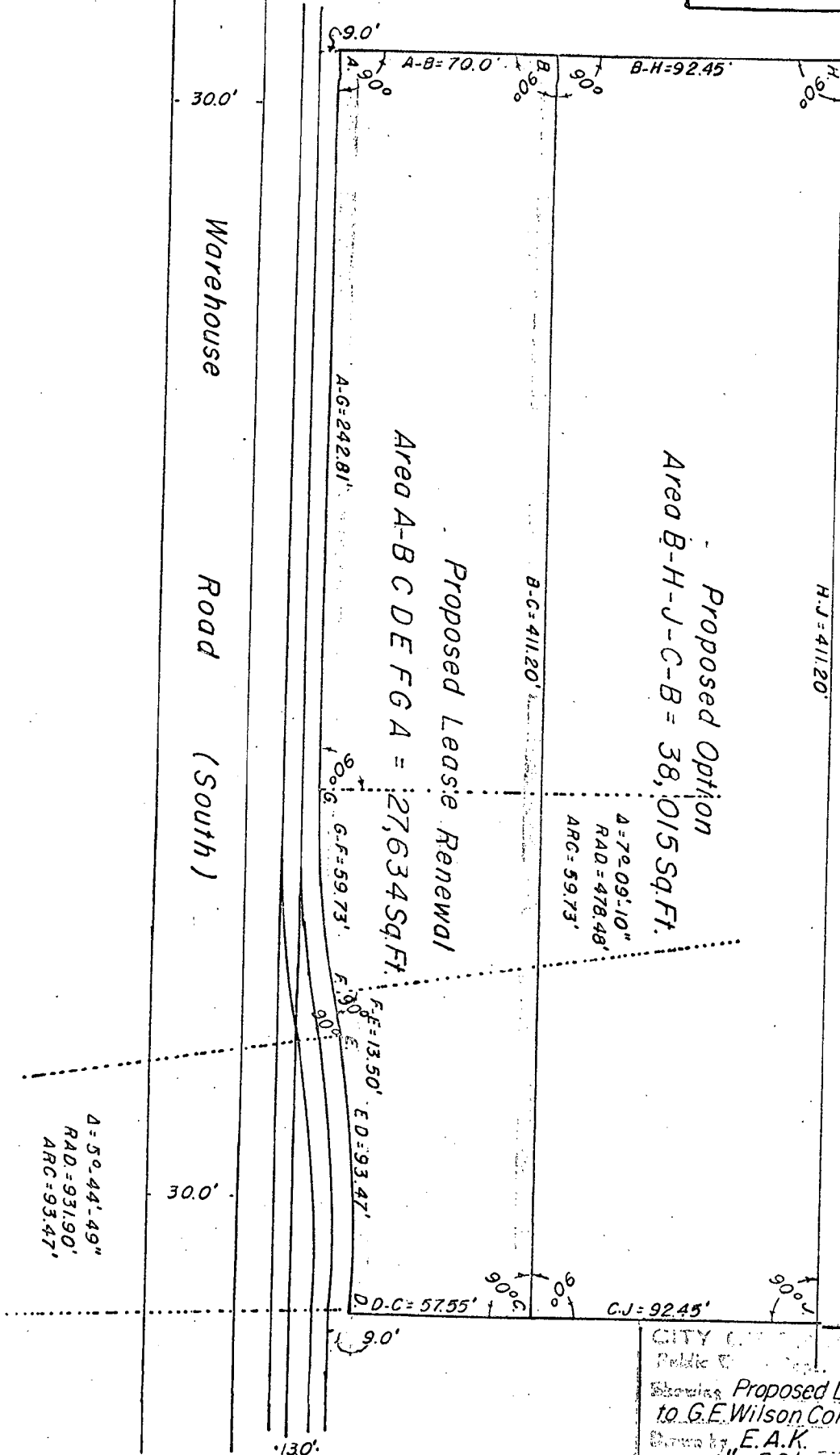
