WHEREAS, The State of Rhode Island, as well as many other states and major cities, has resolved to fly the United States Army flag on June 14, 2008; and

WHEREAS, Flying the United States Army flag over Providence City Hall on the 233rd birthday of the United States Army will honor and recognize the greatness and strength of the United States Army, as well as pay tribute to the soldiers who are currently serving around the world to protect our freedom; and

WHEREAS, The City of Providence desires to honor all our soldiers by display of the United States Army flag in the City of Providence on June 14, 2008.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:


