Dear Mr. Vespia:

In Re: To a pole relocation at 73 Simmons Street namely Pole #2.

At the present time this pole is located at the proper location, on the property line of two adjoining properties. This is a joint owned pole, but it is maintained by the Telephone Company. There are hundreds of other pole locations similar to this throughout the City of Providence.

It has been an established procedure of setting these utility poles (14" wide), splitting the property line of adjoining owners; this way, one pole services (4) houses, two on one side and two on the opposite side of the street, without overhanging any property with the required service connection wires or cable.

However, if the homeowner wishes to contact the utility company and request a relocation, he may. These poles, wires, and any property on them belong to the utility company and are relocated at their expense.
