CHAPTER 69-42

No. **451** **AN ORDINANCE** AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 69-33, APPROVED SEPTEMBER 22, 1969, BY APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF SIXTY THOUSAND (\$60,000) DOLLARS TO MODEL CITIES, ITEM 3.

Approved October 20, 1969

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Chapter 69-33 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, as approved September 22, 1969, entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$52,644,681.82 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Period Beginning October 1, 1969 and Ending June 30, 1970", is hereby amended by appropriating the sum of Sixty Thousand (\$60,000) Dollars to MODEL CITIES, ITEM 3.

SECTION 2. The said sum of Sixty Thousand (\$60,000) Dollars as thus added and appropriated shall be obtained by authorizing and directing the City Controller and the City Treasurer to transfer a like amount from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account to the Receipt Account.

SECTION 3. The estimated receipts from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account are hereby established in the sum of Sixty Thousand (\$60,000) Dollars.

SECTION 4. In order to make the funds available for Model Cities Purposes, the City Controller and the City Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to pay over the sum of Sixty Thousand (\$60,000) Dollars from the General Fund Appropriation account entitled: "MODEL CITIES 87-15, Item 3", to the account in the Federal Program Accounts entitled, "City of Providence Model Cities Agencies Account 15-8104457".

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

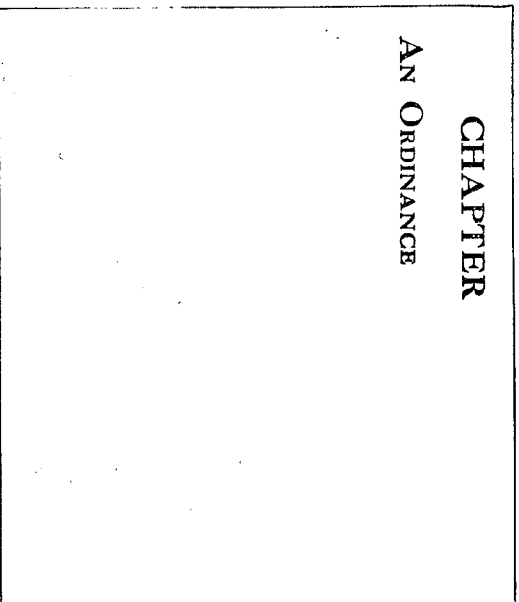

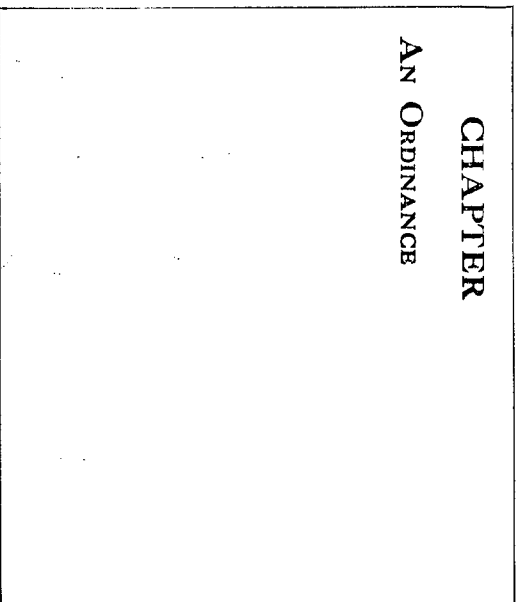

RESOLVED DECREED AND ORDERED, That Wright Street from Hartford Avenue to Stanfield Street shown as cross-hatched area and designated by the letters A-B-C-D-A on the accompanying plan entitled, "Providence, R. I., P. W. Dept.-Engineering Office-City Property Section, Plan No. 063260 Date March 12, 1969", has ceased to be useful to the public and the same is abandoned as a public highway and the damage to the abutters is appraised at nothing and so awarded, and it is further

ORDERED, That the Director of Public Works, be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed on that (Wright Street from Hartford Avenue to Stanfield Street, abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words, "Not a Public Highway", and it is further

ORDERED, That after the entry of this order or decree the City Clerk shall cause a notice thereof to be published in a newspaper published in the County of Providence at least once each week for three successive weeks and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting that (Wright Street From Hartford Avenue to Stanfield Street,) which has been abandoned, who is known to reside within this state.

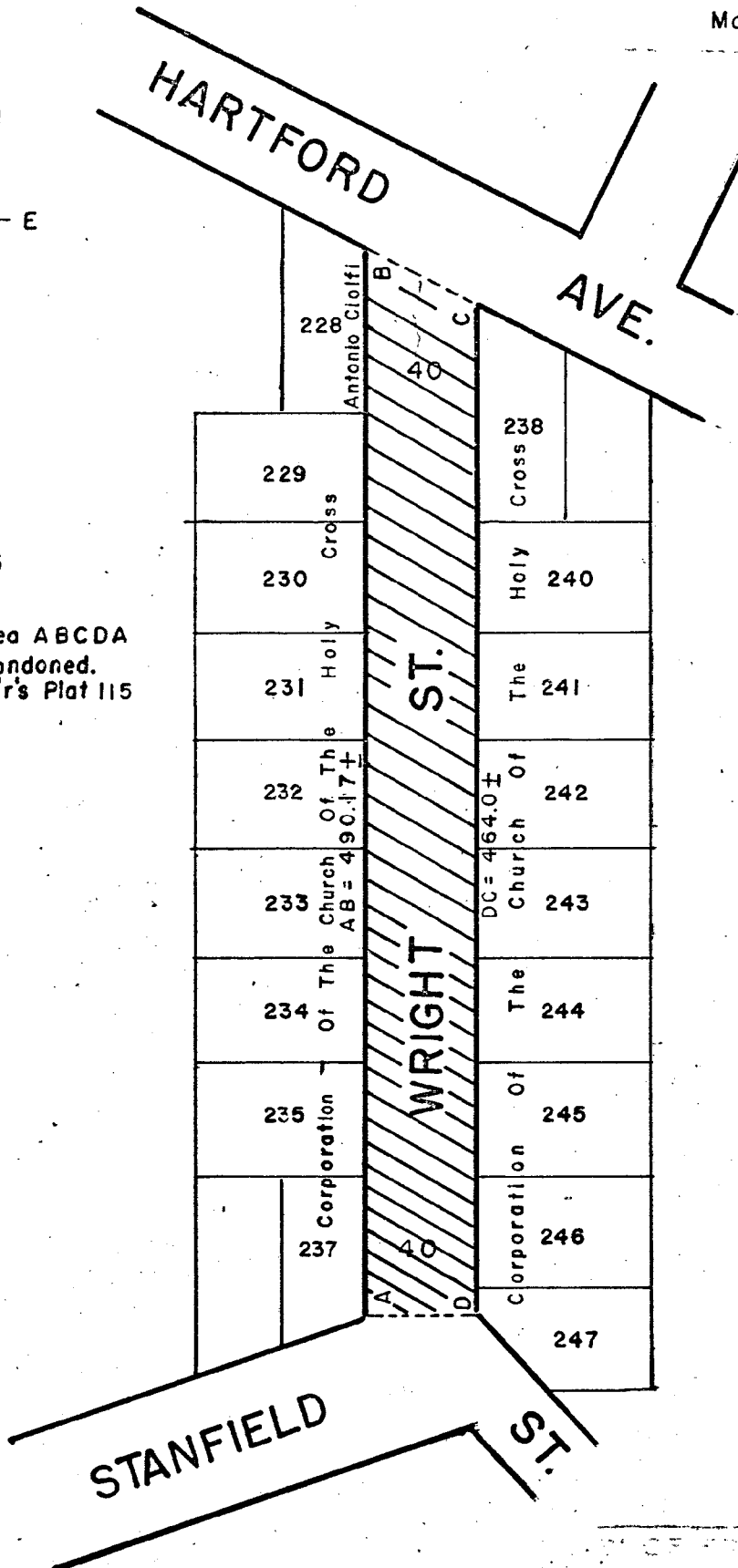




Dear Councilman Payne:

On February 28, we received a memorandum dated February 26 from the Department of the City Clerk together with a copy of a resolution for the abandonment of Wright Street. We find that our facilities in the street to be abandoned have a depreciated value of \$228.55. This amount includes a small amount of miscellaneous work to plug a tee and also install straps.

We are filing a bill with the City Clerk's Office in the above amount and respectfully request that your committee take no action on this matter until the Water Supply Board is assured of payment for the value of the facilities located in the section of the highway to be abandoned.

Also included in this memorandum for abandonment were premises at the corner of Dover Street and Mount Pleasant Avenue in which the Water Supply Board has no facilities.

SUBJECT: Referral No. 1719 - PETITION FOR ABANDONMENT OF WRIGHT STREET


Gentlemen:

This referral from the Committee on Public Works is a petition for the abandonment of Wright Street from Hartford Avenue southerly to Stanfield Street in Assessor's Plat 115.

On a photographic and inspection tour it was determined that Wright Street, as described in the petition, is uncurbed and unpaved. The southerly end, where it connects with Stanfield Street, is an active dumping area. The neighborhood is mixed commercial and residential and in fair to good condition.

The advisability of the abandonment of the land designated as Wright Street as a public highway is dependent on the proposed use of the adjoining property. If the owner or owners of all the property are in agreement that a public right of way is unnecessary at this location, no objections to the abandonment of Wright Street is offered by this department.
