BE IT FURTHER RESOVLED, To cause the installation of a High Pressure Sodium Vapor Light on Pole No. 52 along Admiral Street, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That all street lights in the City of Providence be changed to High Pressure Sodium Vapor Lights of the same illumination as existing Mercury Vapor Lights.
