RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 241

Approved May 28, 2013

WHEREAS, The United States Congress has declared the month of March as Women's History Month; and

WHEREAS, Secretary of State Barbara Leonard served the City of Providence and the State of Rhode Island in numerous ways, including in private enterprise, public office and charitable endeavors; and

WHEREAS, Secretary of State Barbara Leonard held the honor of being the first woman elected to statewide office in Rhode Island; and

WHEREAS, Secretary of State Barbara Leonard was a highly accomplished, civically engaged Providence resident, who served as President of the Rhode Island Philharmonic, as a Trustee of Brown University, Bryant University and the Lincoln School, as a Commissioner on Boards including the Rhode Island Port Authority, the Economic Development Corporation, the Job Training Council and others; and






