Approved September 7, 1990

WHEREAS, Patrolman Moody approached the car in which there were three individuals and noticed the car contained hats marked "police", handcuffs, sirens, together with other items, which would lead one to believe the men were police officers, and

WHEREAS, Upon taking the men to the Police Station for questioning, the police learned of an alleged kidnapping and extortion plot, and

WHEREAS, Due to his heroic actions, Patrolman Moody prevented this alleged kidnapping, and possibly saved the life of the individual,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Members of the City Council hereby commend Patrolman Frank Moody in recognition of his alert and heroic actions in apprehending the three suspects on August 14, 1990 and note with pride his proficiency shown for the protection and betterment of our community.

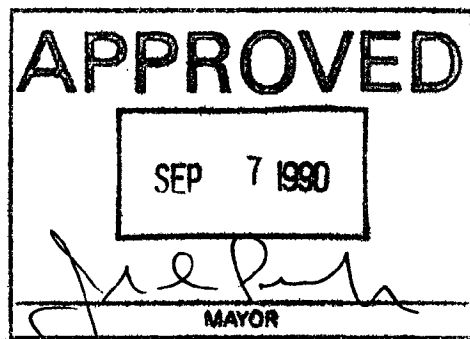

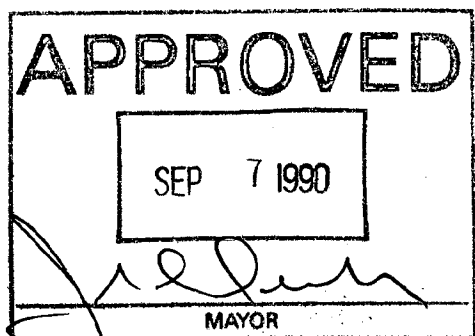
