

WHEREAS, Diamond Centofani, did upon hearing a woman screaming after having her knapsack forcibly removed from her, and


WHEREAS, Mr. Centofani did take chase of the subject that took the knapsack and upon tackling the subject and recovering the knapsack, held the subject for the police,
