

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Approved March 15, 2019

WHEREAS, Under the leadership of Head Coach Bill Belichick, the National Football League's New England Patriots won the Lombardi Trophy for the second time in three seasons; and

WHEREAS, The Patriots had another strong showing this season under the leadership of Coach Belichick and his staff, finishing atop the American Football Conference (AFC) East Division with an 11-5 record and entered the playoffs as the number two (2) seed in the AFC playoffs; and

WHEREAS, After a strong showing in the AFC playoffs, the Patriots made their NFL record eleventh appearance in Super Bowl LIII; and

WHEREAS, The Patriots defeated the Los Angeles Rams in their third consecutive Super Bowl, their fourth Super Bowl in the last five years; and

WHEREAS, The Super Bowl is the highest echelon of professional football competition; and

WHEREAS, This victory marks the franchise's sixth Super Bowl win, tying them with the Pittsburgh Steelers for the most Super Bowl victories in NFL history; and

WHEREAS, The team showed great poise, character, and teamwork, throughout the season; and




