

# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, The Director of the Parks Department and the Director of the Ice Skating Rink have appeared before the Finance Committee of the Providence City Council concerning the operations and financial matters; and

WHEREAS, At that meeting the aforementioned individuals both reported that an accounts receivable payment was forthcoming and those dollars would be used to satisfy "in full" that obligation to the Providence Civic Center the amount of Seventy One Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety Two Dollars and Ninety Four (\$71,892.94) Cents, and

WHEREAS, The Providence Civic Center is in need of every penny of revenue possible to help minimize the inevitable deficit budgeted in fiscal year 2001; and

WHEREAS, The Ice Skating Rink and the Parks Department have received the anticipated payment of approximately Eighty Thousand (\$80,000.00) Dollars and chose not to pay the Providence Civic Center and used the money for other matters.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Finance Committee of the Providence City Council hereby amends the Compensation Ordinance by transferring the amount of moneys owed to the Providence Civic Center in the amount of Seventy One Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety Two Dollars and Ninety Four (\$71,892.94) Cents from the budget of the Park's Department.
