I hereby disapprove and veto the City Council Resolution of August 7, 1980 asking Mr. E. Ashton-Irvine to reconsider his resignation as Port Director of the City of Providence. I take this action because Mr. Ashton-Irvine resigned this position after ten weeks on the job because he sought an additional raise of over \$4,000 after he had been granted a salary upon hiring that was more than average compensation for his post. Moreover, Mr. Ashton-Irvine resigned his position as Port Director freely and willingly with the full intention of accepting another position. Clearly, his record in no way warrants that he be offered the post once again.
