Approved September 8, 1988

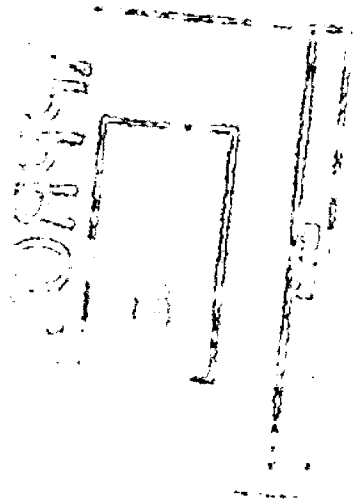
Be it ordained by the City of Providence:
