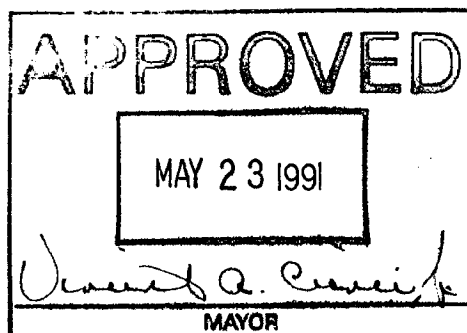
WHEREAS, There have been many incidents of pedestrians throwing rocks from walkways over various highways and more than once, at the Route 195 east overpass, and
