No. 546 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 187.3 OF ARTICLE XV OF CHAPTER 2 OF THE 1946 REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, AS AMENDED, BY CHAPTER 934 OF THE ORDINANCES OF 1955, RELATING TO SICK LEAVE WITH PAY.

Approved September 25, 1967

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Section 187.3 of Article XV of Chapter 2 of the 1946 Revised Ordinances of the City of Providence, approved March 5, 1951, entitled: "An Ordinance Establishing Sick Leaves with Pay for Certain City Employees", as amended by Chapter 934 of the Ordinances of 1955, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 3. Sick leave with full pay for officers and permanent employees subject to the provisions of this Ordinance shall be 1 1/4 working days per month. Such annual sick leave of 15 working days with pay, when not used, shall be cumulative, but the accumulated and unused portion of such sick leave shall not exceed 120 days at any one time; provided, however, any employees with at least ten (10) years of continuous service who contracts a serious illness may be granted, with the approval of the Personnel Director, the Finance Director and the Mayor, a further leave not to exceed ninety (90) days in addition to his accumulated sick leave as of the date said illness occurs."

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

No. 547 AN ORDINANCE FIXING A FILING FEE OF THIRTY-FIVE (\$35.00) DOLLARS FOR PETITIONS TO AMEND THE ZONING ORDINANCE.

Approved September 25, 1967

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

Section 1. No petition for an amendment to the zoning ordinance, including the zoning map, shall be accepted by the Clerk of the City Council, unless accompanied by a filing fee of Thirty-five (\$35.00) Dollars, which shall be deposited with the City Clerk, and no part of which shall be returnable to the petitioner.

Section 2. That portion of Section 102 of Chapter 544 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, approved September 21, 1951, and entitled, "An Ordinance Zoning the City of Providence and Establishing Use, Height and Area Regulations", as amended, insofar as said portion provides for a filing fee of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars for petitions to the City Council to amend the zoning map, is hereby repealed, and all other ordinances or parts thereof, inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

Approved September 25, 1967

RESOLVED,

That in accordance with the provisions of Section 28, Chapter 1665 of the Public Laws of 1945, approved April 27, 1945, the City Controller is hereby authorized and directed to establish in the accounts for the year ending September 30, 1967, a specific purpose account to be known as "Reserve for Revenue for Extraordinary Expenditures of the year 1967-1968". Said account shall be established by charging to the account entitled "Current Year Surplus" of the accounts of 1966-1967, an amount equal to any credit balance existing in said Current Year Surplus account at the close of the fiscal year. After completion of the above transfer, any balance existing in the account entitled "Reserve for Revenue for Extraordinary Expenditures of the Year 1967-1968" shall be carried over to the books of account for the year 1967-1968.

From time to time during the year ending September 30, 1968, the City Council, when necessary, may direct the City Controller and the City Treasurer to pay out of General Fund Cash the total or any part of the then credit balance existing in the account entitled "Reserve for Revenue for Extraordinary Expenditures of the Year 1967-1968", each such payment shall be charged to said account and shall immediately be paid over to the City Collector as a receipt account, and when so received by him, shall be credited to a receipt account to be entitled "Receipts for Extraordinary Expenditures of the year 1967-1968".
