RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, A vacancy exists in the Office of Councilman from the Third Ward in the City of Providence, Rhode Island, caused by the resignation on May 15, 1981 of Philip F. Addison, Jr., and

WHEREAS, The said vacancy did occur more than One Hundred Eighty Days before the time of holding the next succeeding regular City Election, and

WHEREAS, In accordance with the provisions of Section 3.4 of the Charter of the City of Providence, Rhode Island, and by Section 1 of Chapter 2864 of the Public Laws of 1951, approved May 1, 1951, it is mandatory that a Special Election for the purpose of filling such vacancy be held within ninety days of the date of the occurrence of such vacancy,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the City Council of the City of Providence, Rhode Island, that in compliance with the provisions of the governing statutes, the said City Council does hereby order a Special Election to be held for the purpose of filling the vacancy in the Office of Councilman from the Third Ward of Providence, Rhode Island, caused by the resignation of Philip F. Addison, Jr., on the Second Thursday of August, 1981, being also August 13, 1981, said date being within ninety days from the date of occurrence of said vacancy, and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Canvassers and Registration of the City of Providence, Rhode Island and all other officers whose duty it is to prepare for elections, are hereby requested and notified to make such preparations for said election as are required by Law, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Clerk is directed to cause a Certified Copy of this Resolution to be transmitted to the Board of Canvassers and Registration of the City of Providence, Rhode Island, and that a duly Certified Copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the State Board of Elections and to the Secretary of State.
