## CHAPTER 70-14

No. **141** **AN ORDINANCE** TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUE OF \$5,000,000 REDEVELOPMENT and SLUM CLEARANCE BONDS UNDER SECTION 45-33-1 OF THE GENERAL LAWS.

Approved April 20, 1970

*Be it ordained by the City of Providence:*

SECTION 1. The sum of \$5,000,000 shall be borrowed for the purposes of the Redevelopment Revolving Fund of the City of Providence. The City Treasurer, with the approval of the Mayor and the Committee on Finance, is authorized to issue \$5,000,000 Redevelopment and Slum Clearance Bonds pursuant to Section 45-33-1 of the General Laws as amended and, subject to the foregoing, to determine the denominations, interest rate or rates, and other terms, conditions and details of the bonds in accordance with law.

SECTION 2. The bonds shall be issued originally as coupon bonds in substantially the form approved by the City Council in Resolution No. 63, approved February 21, 1968. The bonds shall be sold at public sale at not less than par and accrued interest and shall bear such date or dates as the City Council shall determine by resolution and shall be payable in annual installments commencing not later than five years and ending not later than twenty-five years from their date or dates as the City Council shall determine by resolution.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and all other ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

No. **142** **AN ORDINANCE** TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUE OF \$500,000  
HIGHWAY BONDS PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 83 OF THE PUBLIC LAWS OF 1964.

Approved April 20, 1970

*Be it ordained by the City of Providence:*

SECTION 1. The sum of \$500,000 shall be borrowed for the purpose of constructing and repairing highways in the City of Providence including the acquisition of land in said City of Providence for highway purposes. The City Treasurer, with the approval of the Mayor and the Committee on Finance, is authorized to issue \$500,000 Highway Bonds pursuant to Chapter 83 of the Public Laws of 1964 and, subject to the foregoing, to determine the denominations, interest rate or rates, and other terms, conditions and details of the bonds in accordance with law.

SECTION 2. The bonds shall be issued originally as coupon bonds in substantially the form approved by the City Council in Resolution No. 63, approved February 21, 1968. The bonds shall be sold at public sale at not less than par and accrued interest and shall bear such date or dates as the City Council shall determine by resolution and shall be payable in annual installments commencing not later than five years and ending not later than twenty-five years from their date or dates as the City Council shall determine by resolution.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and all other ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

No. **143** AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUE OF \$1,000,000 SCHOOL MODERNIZATION BONDS PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 24 OF THE PUBLIC LAWS OF 1958.

Approved April 20, 1970

*Be it ordained by the City of Providence:*

SECTION 1. The sum of \$1,000,000 shall be borrowed for the repair, modernization, construction and reconstruction, furnishing and equipping of the Classical High School in the City of Providence, including the acquisition of any additional land therefore by purchase or condemnation. The City Treasurer, with the approval of the Mayor and the Committee on Finance, is authorized to issue \$1,000,000 School Modernization Bonds pursuant to Chapter 24 of the Public Laws of 1958 and, subject to the foregoing, to determine the denominations, interest rate or rates, and other terms, conditions and details of the bonds in accordance with law.

SECTION 2. The bonds shall be issued originally as coupon bonds in substantially the form approved by the City Council in Resolution No. 63, approved February 21, 1968. The bonds shall be sold at public sale at not less than par and accrued interest and shall bear such date or dates as the City Council shall determine by resolution and shall be payable in annual installments commencing not later than five years and ending not later than twenty-five years from their date or dates as the City Council shall determine by resolution.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and all other ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

No. **144** AN ORDINANCE In amendment of Section 17-75 of its Code of Ordinances of the City of Providence

Approved April 20, 1970

*Be it ordained by the City of Providence:*

Section 1. Section 17-75 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Providence is hereby amended to read as follows:

"The Mayor, the director of public works, the personnel director and the finance director are hereby created a commission with authority to provide for the relief of such employees of the various departments of the city, excluding policemen and firemen and employees otherwise provided for who shall be injured or disabled while in the actual discharge of their duties as such employees and as a result thereof, in accordance with and subject to the conditions prescribed in section 17-76.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage.

### AN ACT

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE TO ISSUE  
ADDITIONAL BONDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT EXCEEDING \$4,000,000  
FOR CONSTRUCTING A CIVIC CENTER AND AMENDING CHAPTER 3  
OF THE PUBLIC LAWS OF 1969

*It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:*

Section 1. The first sentence of section 13 of Chapter 3 of the Public Laws of 1969 is amended by striking out the words "six million dollars" and by substituting the words "ten million dollars" so that said sentence shall read as follows: "The City of Providence is hereby authorized, in addition to authority previously granted, to issue bonds to an amount not exceeding ten million dollars from time to time under its corporate name and seal or a facsimile of such seal." Said section 13 is further amended by deleting the next to the last sentence which reads as follows: "The bonds of each issue shall bear interest at a rate or rates not exceeding six percent per annum."

Section 2. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this act, none of the additional bonds authorized hereunder shall be issued in excess of the amounts approved from time to time by a majority of the electors of the City of Providence at the election or elections hereinafter specified. The question of the approval of an issue of said additional bonds shall be submitted to the electors or the City of Providence at the regular municipal election to be held on November 3, 1970. The question shall be submitted in substantially the following form: "Shall bonds in the amount of \$\_\_\_\_\_ be issued for the construction of a

civic center in addition to bonds previously authorized?" The amount of bonds contained in the question shall be fixed by resolution of the city council. If the amount of bonds contained in the question is less than \$4,000,000 the city council may submit the question of approving the balance of the additional \$4,000,000 from time to time to the electors at any city wide election, other than a primary, held for other purposes not later than February 1, 1972. The question shall be in substantially the same form as the question submitted at the regular municipal election. Sections 5(a) and 135 of Chapter 832 of the Public Laws of 1940, as amended by Chapter 1266 of the Public Laws of 1943 shall not apply to the elections hereunder and the validity of the elections shall not be affected by the provisions of section 153 of Chapter 2 of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Providence, 1946. Chapter 3526 of the Public Laws of 1955 shall apply.

Section 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
