

# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Approved January 13, 1978

WHEREAS, the Union Avenue Bridge is considered to be in deplorable condition and hazardous to motor vehicles traveling over and across said Bridge, and

WHEREAS, the said Bridge, having formerly been maintained by the New York, New Haven and Hartford Railroad, has been neglected to a serious extent by Penn Central Railroad Company, successor to New York, New Haven and Hartford Railroad Co.,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Director of Public Works is hereby requested to cause the Union Avenue Bridge to be Repaired to eliminate that hazard resulting from its neglect and deterioration.
