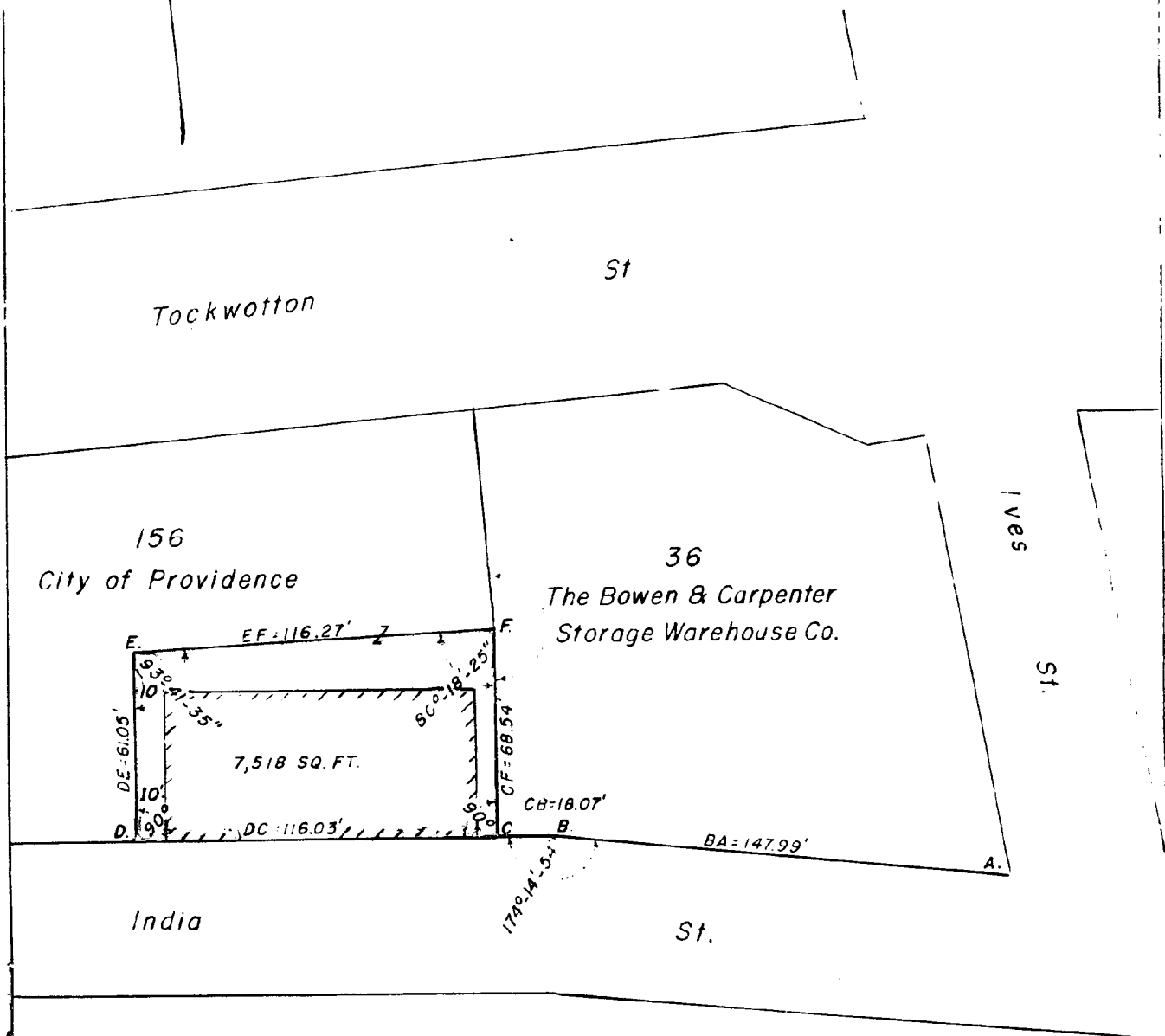

Gentlemen:

We have requested that a portion of Whitmarsh Street from Bucklin Street to Dexter Street be abandoned in order that parking of automobiles be prevented. We cannot maintain turf on a playground if automobiles are constantly passing over the playing surface. In the early spring when the frost is coming out of the ground ruts are so deep that seeding of the area in the previous fall is a waste of money.

Since it is impossible to maintain turf the dust that develops in the spring and summer makes living conditions unbearable for the families in the neighborhood. We are going to erect a chain-link fence on the Bucklin Street side some three hundred feet in length to prevent automobiles from entering the area in order to eliminate the nuisance and hold the turf to prevent dust from going into the homes of the nearby residents.

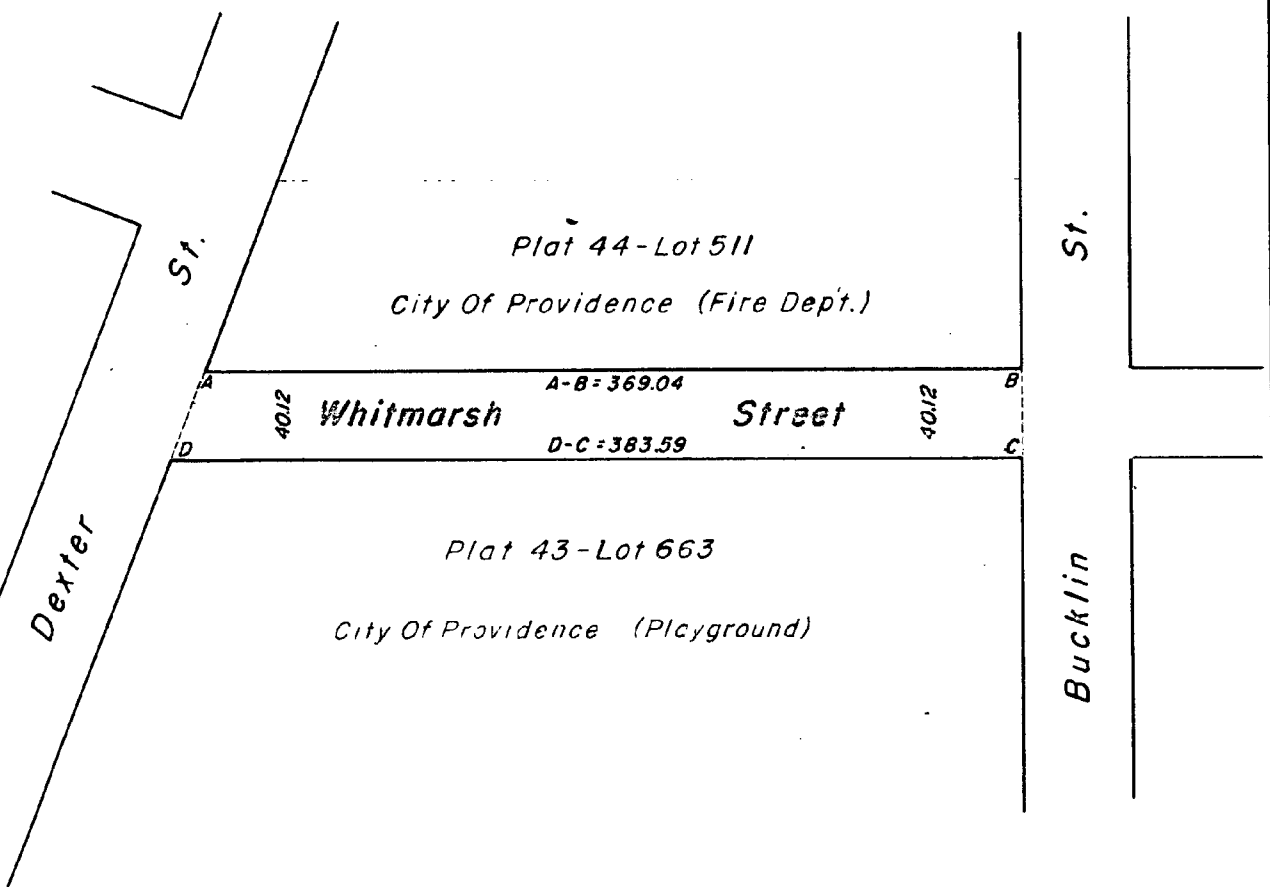
