AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT OF AND IN ADDITION TO CHAPTER 1977-15 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE APPROVED APRIL 28, 1977 AND ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE OFFICIAL REDEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR FEDERAL HILL EAST"

Approved December 9, 1977

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

1. That Chapter 1977-15 of the Ordinance of the City of Providence approved April 28, 1977 and entitled, "An Ordinance Approving and adopting the Official Redevelopment Plan for Federal Hill East" be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

A.Paragraph numbered 7 entitled "Estimated Cost of Redevelopment and Proposed Method of Financing" as contained in and set forth at the top of page 33 of that certain booklet entitled "Federal Hill East, Official Redevelopment Plan, 1977", which is a part of the aforementioned ordinance be and the same is hereby deleted and the following substituted therefor:

7. Estimated Cost of Redevelopment and Proposed Method of Financing

The estimated project cost of \$3,610,487.00 will be provided from proceeds from the sale of long-term general obligation bonds issued by the City of Providence for redevelopment purposes.

In addition, efforts will be made to obtain funding through the Public Works Employment Act of 1976. If such funding becomes available it will be utilizes to reduce the funds required from the sale of general obligation bonds.

2. That said Chapter 1977-15 of the Ordinance of the City of Providence as adopted and as heretofore amended, be and the same is hereby ratified and affirmed in all other respects.

3. That this Ordinance shall take effect on its passage and shall be filed with the City Clerk who is hereby authorized and directed to forward a certified copy thereof to the Providence Redevelopment Agency.

Dear Mrs. Mendonca:

Enclosed is an original and ten (10) copies of an Ordinance in Amendment of the Federal Hill East Redevelopment Plan.

This Amendment provides for an increase in the cost of Redevelopment from \$3,053,546.00 to \$3,610,487.00.

The Providence Redevelopment Agency voted to approve this amendment to the Federal Hill East Urban Renewal Plan, based on our consultant's estimated increased costs for the site improvements along Atwells Avenue. One of the major items that reflect this increased cost is the necessity for removing and replacing the entire roadbase along Atwells Avenue. The Federal Hill East Project has had considerable citizens' input, and the Federal Hill Businessmen's Association is on record as supporting this amendment.

It is respectfully requested that this Ordinance be placed on the Docket for the next scheduled meeting of the Providence City Council.
