WHEREAS, The Reverend Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Hall of Fame recognizes individuals who carry on the legacy of the late Reverend Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. within the community; and

WHEREAS, Angela Bannerman Ankoma is the Vice President, Executive Director of Equity Leadership at the Rhode Island Foundation; and

WHEREAS, Ankoma previously served as Executive Vice President, Director of Community Investment at United Way of Rhode Island (UWRI) and the Rhode Island Department of Health, where she was a founding Co-Director of the Health Equity Institute; and

WHEREAS, Ankoma is a board member of the West Elmwood Housing Development Corporation (WEHDC) and a founding member of the WEHDC's Sankofa Initiative which works to address modern health, financial and community challenges through increased access to the healthy foods that are traditional to the West End's ethnically diverse community; and



WHEREAS, Ankoma also serves on the advisory boards of the Latino Policy Institute and Amos House; and

WHEREAS, Angela Bannerman Ankoma is an outstanding member of the Providence community and a deserving 2022 inductee of the Reverend Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Hall of Fame.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Providence City Council hereby extends its most sincere congratulations to Angela Bannerman Ankoma on her induction to the City of Providence Reverend Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Hall of Fame.
