# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 512

Approved August 15, 1980

WHEREAS, City Council Resolution No. 311, approved May 23, 1978, authorized the Mayor to Execute a deed of conveyance to Alfred Calcagni and Son, Inc. for Thirteen (13) single Family houses within the area known as the "Forestry Circle and Subdivision of Lot No. 137, on City Assessor's Plat 90", and

WHEREAS, Section (d) of that Resolution states that the proceeds of that sale shall be transferred to the City of Providence Parks Department, in accordance with the terms of sale of Parks Lands, which has not been complied with, as the money has gone into the General Fund, and

WHEREAS, Payment to the Auctioneer was agreed upon by the Committee and the Superintendent of the Park Department to be paid by that Department from the proceeds of the sale,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Acting City Controller is hereby directed to issue payment to William J. Canning and Company, 34 Pontiac Avenue, Providence, Rhode Island in the sum of One Thousand Three Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$1,350.00) for the Auctioneer's Fees owed due to the sale of land located along Netop Drive; payment to be made from the General Fund.
