(REVISED)

The office of Traffic Engineering has investigated the request for a 4-WAY STOP at the intersection of Unit Street and Almira Avenue and has the following to offer:

Out of all the possible warrants for STOP sign applications, the only warrant that this request can be considered for review is the accident history.

The accident history is as follows:

2001	0	2007	0
2002	0	2008	0

**The average is 0.09 over an eleven (11) year period.**

Based on a review of the system warrant requirements, this intersection **DOES NOT** qualify for the installation of a 4-WAY STOP SIGN according to the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices. The installation of a 4-WAY STOP SIGN at this intersection is not justified nor warranted.
