RESOLVED, DECREED AND ORDERED:

That the following named highway shown as the shaded area on the accompanying plan entitled "Providence, Rhode Island, Public Works Department, Engineering Office, Street Line Section Map No. 063573, dated August 15, 1972,"

viz:

Mathewson Street (portion) from the southwesterly line of Fountain Street, to the proposed new southeasterly line of Sabin Street, Area ABCDA, having ceased to be useful to the public and the same is abandoned as a public highway and the damage to the abutters is appraised at nothing and so awarded, and it is further

ORDERED, that the Director of Public Works, be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed on the above-named highway abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words "Not a Public Highway," and it is further

ORDERED, That after the entry of this order or decree the City Clerk shall cause a notice thereof to be published in a newspaper published in the County of Providence at least once each week for three successive weeks and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting the above-named highway which have been abandoned, who is known to reside within this State.

TO THE HONORABLE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE:

PROVIDENCE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, an agency established by the General Assembly of the State of Rhode Island as a public body corporate and agency of the State, and PROVIDENCE JOURNAL COMPANY, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Rhode Island, respectfully represent:

FIRST: That your petitioners, Providence Redevelopment Agency and Providence Journal Company, are the owners in fee of all of the land bounding on that portion of Mathewson Street lying between Sabin Street and Fountain Street in the City of Providence, as described and shown on a plan of land designated on Plan No. 063573 Date August 15, 1972, Providence, R. I. Public Works Dept. - Engineering Office attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECOND: That the portion of Mathewson Street as described and shown on said Plan No. 063573 has ceased to be useful to the public.


THIRD: That in the event this Honorable City Council shall see fit to abandon the aforesaid portion of Mathewson Street, your petitioners hereby agree to waive any and all rights to receive compensation from the City of Providence for damages sustained by them by reason of such abandonment and will exonerate and hold harmless said City of Providence from all legal damages, if any, caused to any persons whatsoever and for which

said City is or may become legally liable by or on account of such abandonment.

WHEREFORE, your petitioners pray that this Honorable City Council declare that that portion of Mathewson Street as shown on said Plan No. 063573 has ceased to be useful to the public and that this Honorable City Council abandon said portion of said Mathewson Street.

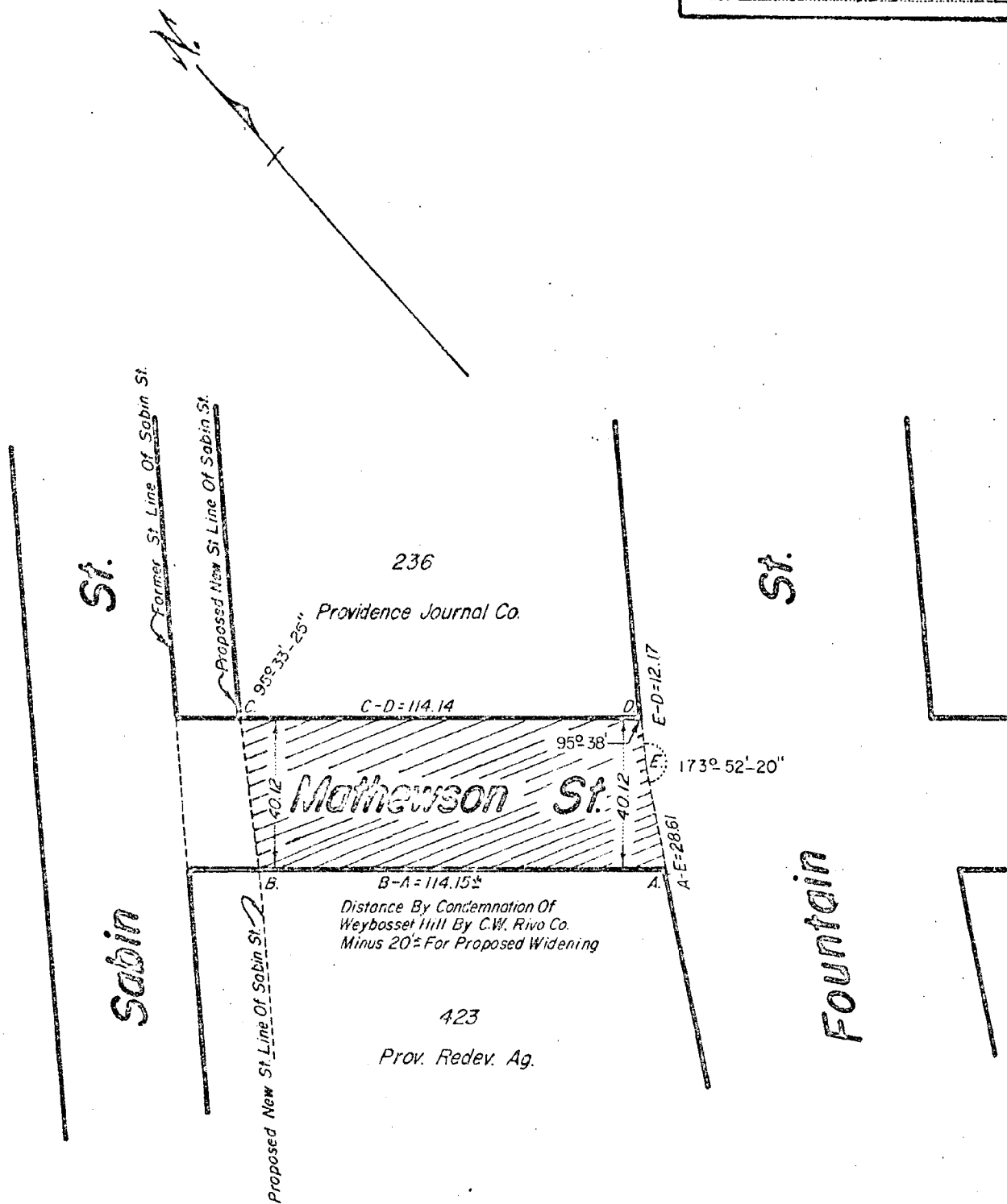



The petition for the abandonment of portions of the above captioned streets have been studied by this department, and it is recommended that neither Aleppo Street nor South Street be abandoned, because of existing sewers within the streets. Aleppo Street contains a 36" combination sewer and a slot manhole. South Street contains a 12" sanitary sewer and also an 18" and 24" storm sewer.

It is recommended that Mathewson Street, (Between Fountain St. & Sabin St.) to the proposed street line of Sabin Street be abandoned as indicated on Plan No. 063573, P.W. Dept.-Engineering Office, Street Line Section, Date: August 15, 1972.


On August 22, 1972 we received a memorandum from the City Clerk's Office relative to petitions for the abandonment of a portion of the following public highways:
