

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 128

Approved April 22, 2020

WHEREAS, The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, is a recognized pandemic that has spread globally and threatens the health, well-being, and financial stability of community members globally; and

WHEREAS, On March 9, 2020, Governor of Rhode Island Gina Raimondo declared, by Executive Order 20-02, a Declaration of Disaster Emergency in connection with the outbreak of the novel coronavirus "COVID-19"; and

WHEREAS, On March 12, 2020, Providence Mayor Jorge Elorza declared a state of emergency for the City of Providence; and

WHEREAS, The City of Providence, like the State of Rhode Island, has a large population of immigrants who are in varying stages of the immigration process to become naturalized citizens of the United States; and

WHEREAS, COVID-19 has had a devastating effect on the local economy, especially small businesses, which has resulted in widespread unemployment and economic harm to a large portion of Rhode Islanders; and

WHEREAS, There are several economic relief efforts currently managed by the State of Rhode Island to provide assistance to Rhode Islanders who have been impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.


